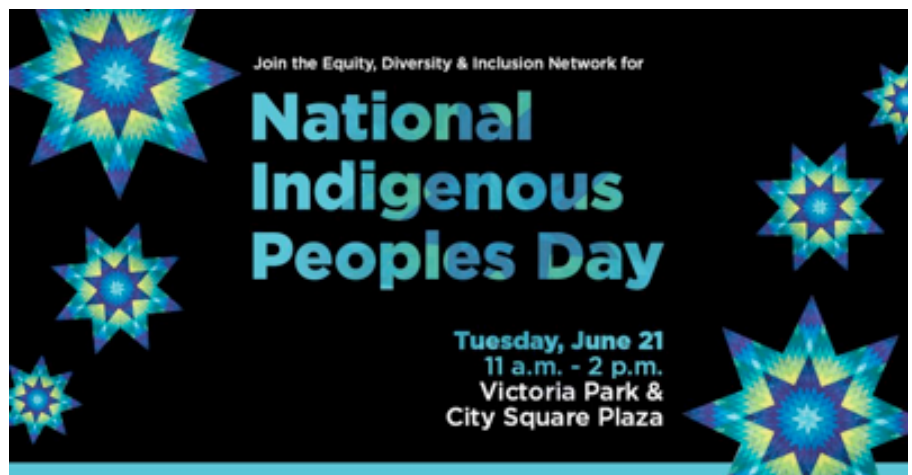


## Performances, speakers planned for first-ever Miyo-wîcîwitowin Day

## Longarm Type Quilting Samples

(Ed. note: good primer for free motion motifs)

Quilters sometimes begin quilting using pantographs, stencils or repetitive, planned designs.

They are safe and predetermined designs that assist us in getting quilts completed. Eventually, many quilters strive to learn more unique patterns for edge-to-edge that they can make their own. Whether you see them as free motion quilting designs or longarm quilting designs, every design can be adapted to the domestic as well as mid-arm sewing machines.

Your instructor demonstrates a wide range of stitch designs and their variations.

## Tips for Using Invisible Thread

Using invisible thread can be a great way to allow the fabric and pieced pattern of the quilt to be the star of the design, rather than the quilting itself. However, using invisible thread can be more challenging than using regular cotton or polyester thread.

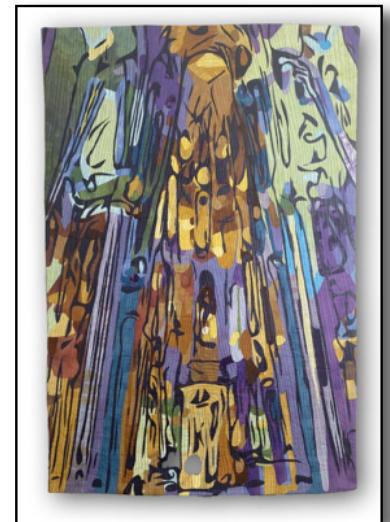

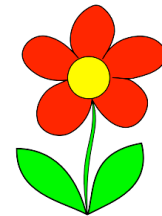

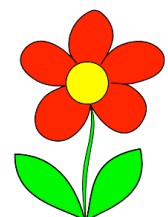
